2. **Chairman's Comments:**
Arwyn Jones opened the meeting thanking all for attending and sent his best wishes to Eric Harries & Arwyn Davies for a speedy recovery.
3. **Declaration of Interests**
No matters were noted.
4. **To confirm minutes of the previous meeting**
The minutes of the meeting held on the 17th of May 2021 were read, agreed and signed as a true record.
5. **To discuss matters arising from the minutes**
 - Ronanny - Due to the Coronavirus restrictions Mr Tony Williams had been unable to arrange a meeting to date.
